We welcome players of all ability levels. Upon arrival at camp, each camper is evaluated by the director and staff and then grouped according to both age and ability.

Improvement Programs

All Skill Levels: ages 8-17

Are geared to beginners, intermediate, advanced, tournament and High School players and include concentrated work to develop the proper fundamentals of tennis (ground strokes, serve, volley, return of serve, overhead) and improve the camper's competitive play (singles and doubles).

Tournament Training Sessions: ages 9-17

Are geared to players competing at the (USTA) tournament level, including extensive fundamental work, physical conditioning and competitive play with the goal of improving each player's tournament results.

High School Sessions: ages 13-18

Are geared to players who are on, or expect to be on, their High School tennis teams. Similar to the Tournament sessions (but with a minimum age of 13) they are geared to turn each player into a better competitor through fundamental development, physical conditioning and match play so that they can make the team or move up the High School ladder.

Quick Start Program: ages 5-7

A positive introduction to tennis fundamentals and low key match play situations for younger campers. The programs will use short court teaching. This is a new, fun teaching system developed by the United States Tennis Association.

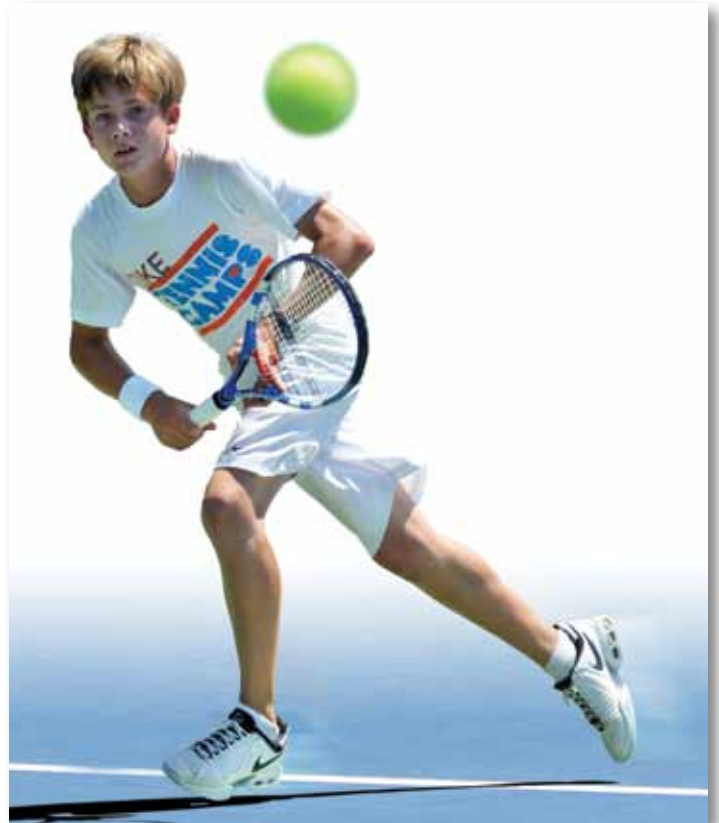
